

DISTRICT 1 RULES 2010

CLASSES: Classes for District 1 are as follows:

<u>Men's Release, Fixed Sights</u>	male shooting a release with fixed sights; stabilizer must be less than 14" – (green stakes)
<u>Men's Bowhunter Open</u>	male shooting release with movable sights or with stabilizer over 14" – (orange stakes)
<u>Women's Release, Fixed Sights</u>	woman shooting a release with fixed sights; stabilizer must be less than 14" – (yellow stakes)
<u>Women's Bowhunter Open</u>	woman shooting a release with movable sights or with stabilizer over 14" – (yellow stakes)
<u>Men's Fingers</u>	male shooting fingers with fixed sights – (green stakes)
<u>Women's Fingers</u>	woman shooting fingers with fixed sights; stabilizer must be less than 14" – (yellow stakes)
<u>Men's Traditional</u>	male shooting a Longbow, Recurve, Stickbow without sights (Compounds excluded) – (yellow stakes)
<u>Women's Traditional</u>	woman shooting a Longbow, Recurve, Stickbow without sights (Compounds excluded) – (yellow stakes)
<u>Junior Boy's Release</u>	boys (13 - 15) shooting a release with fixed or movable sights – (yellow stakes)
<u>Junior Boy's Fingers</u>	boys (13 - 15) shooting fingers with fixed sights – (yellow stakes)
<u>Junior Boy's Traditional</u>	boys (13 - 15) shooting a Longbow, Recurve, Stickbow without sights (Compounds excluded) – (yellow stakes)
<u>Junior Girl's Release</u>	girls (13 - 15) shooting a release with fixed or movable sights – (yellow stakes)
<u>Junior Girl's Fingers</u>	girls (13 - 15) shooting fingers with fixed sights – (yellow stakes)
<u>Junior Girl's Traditional</u>	girls (13 - 15) shooting a Longbow, Recurve, Stickbow without sights (Compounds excluded) – (yellow stakes)
<u>Crossbow</u>	male or female, unlimited – (green stakes) (Except for Round Robin shoots, use of crossbows is at discretion of club hosting shoot)
<u>Seniors</u>	all shooters 50 years and older, unlimited equipment – (green stakes)
<u>Cubs</u>	boys and girls ages (10 -12) shooting fingers or release with fixed or movable sights – (white stakes)
<u>Pee Wees</u>	boys and girls ages (9 and under) shooting fingers or release with fixed or movable sights – (white stakes)

- Juniors will move to adult classes on their 16th birthday.
- Cubs will move to junior classes on their 13th birthday.
- Pee Wees will move to Cubs on their 10th birthday.
- All unaided compound shooters will shoot from the traditional stake (Yellow)

FEES: McKenzie target shoots will be \$ 10.00 for adults and \$5.00 for juniors. Youths (ages 12 and under) will shoot free. There is a maximum \$20.00 charge per family. *** Fees may vary for special club events***

SHOOTING STAKE COLORS:

White = Cubs/PeeWees * Yellow = Women & Traditional * Green = Bowhunter * Orange = Open

REGISTRATION TIME: 9:00 A.M. - 1:00 P.M. Score cards must be turned in by 4:00 P.M. to have scores counted for awards.

TROPHIES: The number of trophies awarded in each class is based upon the number of shooters in each class:

1 Shooter 1 Trophy

5 Shooters 2 Trophies

7 Shooters 3 Trophies

*** Anyone not present or not making arrangements for someone to pick up their trophy when trophies are presented will forfeit their place.

SCORING: Eleven rings will be counted. Scoring is to be posted at all shoots. If arrow shaft touches the line, the next higher score counts. No score for antlers or hooves on McKenzie targets. Glancing shots will be scored as zero. The arrow must stick in the target. Any "pass throughs", if witnessed, may be re-shot.

SHOOTING: Four (4) people from any club may shoot together in a group (5 including a cub or peewee), THIS ALSO APPLIES TO ANY ROUND ROBIN SHOOT. Shooters must touch the stake while shooting.

Clubs are to have rules posted at registration for all shoots.

MAXIMUM TARGET DISTANCES WILL BE:

(WHITE STAKES) – 20 YARDS FOR CUBS & PEEWEES

(YELLOW STAKES) – 30 YARDS FOR WOMEN, TRADITIONAL & JUNIORS

(GREEN STAKES) – 40 YARDS FOR MEN

(ORANGE STAKES) – 50 YARDS for MENS OPEN

***All maximum target distances are approximate and due to human error targets may be set slightly over the defined distances (by a reasonable margin). However, all clubs are encouraged to try their best to stay within the maximum distances.

** OTHER RULES THAT APPLY: MAXIMUM DRAW WEIGHT OF EIGHTY (80) POUNDS and NO RANGE FINDERS

DISTRICT 1 ROUND ROBIN RULES FOR 2010

NOTE: REGISTRATION TIME FOR ROUND ROBIN SHOOTS WILL BE 9:00 AM – 2:00 PM SCORE MUST BE IN BY 5:00 PM TO COUNT. ALL SHOOTERS MUST START ON TARGET #1 AFTER 12 NOON.

- 1) A carbon copy of scores for each Round Robin shoot **must** be sent to the District 1 Chairman and each club representative within two (2) days of the shoot if they are not present to pick up scores.
- 2) No person will shoot the course alone; one other person must accompany you.
- 3) Shooters may represent only one (1) club during the entire Round Robin schedule.
- 4) McKenzie style targets will be used by all clubs. There will be thirty (30) targets (maximum of two (2) small targets (turkeys/rock rascals, etc.). One (1) arrow per target. Scoring will be 11 - 10 - 8 - 5. Maximum distance for all Round Robins will be 40 yards, 30 yards for Women & Traditional Class, 20 yards for Cubs & Pee Wees. . * *It will be up to each clubs discretion as to whether they set a 50 yard stake for anyone wanting to shoot the longer distance shots.*
- 5) Round Robin shooting fees will be \$10.00 for adults and juniors
- 6) Each club must register at least ten (10) shooters or pay the host club the difference. No shooter will be allowed to shoot twice to "fill in" for missing shooters.
- 7) Only the Top Ten (10) scores from each club will be counted.
- 8) Maximum group size is four (4) people (5 counting one cub or peewee).
- 9) All clubs Round Robin fees (\$25.00) must be paid before or by the end of the first Round Robin shoot. Any club not paying their fee by the end of the first Round Robin shoot will forfeit their scores. **No Exceptions**. Club fee payback as follows:
First Place.....50% Second Place..30% Third Place..20%
- 10) Cost per shooter will be \$10.00 for adults & juniors, with family cap of \$20.00. One dollar of this fee will go into a 'kitty' to be paid back to top 3 clubs in same percentages as Club fee payback. The registration fee of \$10.00 for non-member shooters will go to the host club.
- 11) There will be a traveling trophy that will be passed each year to the winning club.
- 12) All individuals **must** show proof of **paid membership** when registering at all Round Robin shoots.
- 13) The cumulative Round Robin scores for each club (not each shooter) must be posted by the close of registration of each Round Robin shoot. This is to be done by the District 1 Chairman.
- 14) The 2010 annual meeting of the District 1 representatives from the participating clubs will be held on Sunday, September 19, 2010 at Apache Bowhunters Club, following the close of their 2 Day shoot.
- 15) All Round Robin rules are to be posted at registration at each Round Robin shoot.
